

Take a ruler and find the “bump” in between the ears, on the back skull of your corso. This is the occipital bone. Place one end there. Hold the ruler horizontally over the head and measure the length between the occipital bone (bump) and the tip of the nose. Then place the ruler on the bridge of the muzzle with the end firmly against the stop; measure to tip of the nose. The second measurement should be no more than a third of the first measurement. If it is, your dogs muzzle is too short.
